If I said the phrase "I am the greatest", who would come to mind? I imagine most of you would say Mohammed Ali, the professional boxing personality formally called Cassius Clay, who used the phrase about himself. The story of the saying is described in Wikipedia:

By late 1963, Clay had become the top contender for Sonny Liston's title. The fight was set for February 25, 1964, in <u>Miami Beach</u>. Liston was an intimidating personality, a dominating fighter with a criminal past and ties to the mob. ..., Clay was a 7–1 underdog. Despite this, Clay taunted Liston during the pre-fight buildup, dubbing him "the big ugly bear", stating "Liston even smells like a bear" and claiming "After I beat him I'm going to donate him to the zoo." [62] .....

The outcome of the fight was a major upset. At the opening bell, Liston rushed at Clay, seemingly angry and looking for a quick knockout. However, Clay's superior speed and mobility enabled him to elude Liston, making the champion miss and look awkward. At the end of the first round, Clay opened up his attack and hit Liston repeatedly with jabs. Liston fought better in round two, but at the beginning of the third round Clay hit Liston with a combination that buckled his knees and opened a cut under his left eye. This was the first time Liston had ever been cut. At the end of round four, Clay was returning to his corner when he began experiencing blinding pain in his eyes and asked his trainer, <u>Angelo Dundee</u>, to cut off his gloves. Dundee refused. It has been speculated that the problem was due to ointment used to seal Liston's cuts, perhaps deliberately applied by his corner to his gloves.

Despite Liston's attempts to knock out a blinded Clay, Clay was able to survive the fifth round until sweat and tears rinsed the irritation from his eyes. In the sixth, Clay dominated, hitting Liston repeatedly. Liston did not answer the bell for the seventh round, and Clay was declared the winner by <u>TKO</u>. Liston stated that the reason he quit was an injured shoulder. Following the win, a triumphant Clay rushed to the edge of the ring and, pointing to the ringside press, shouted: "Eat your words!" He added, "I am the greatest! I shook up the world. I'm the prettiest thing that ever lived."

- 5. Left a congregation of about two million.
- 6. Was the leader of a nation for 40 years.

v1 Therefore, holy brothers, who share in the heavenly calling, fix your thoughts on Jesus, **the apostle** and high priest whom we confess.

The word "apostle" simply means "One who was sent." This is the only reference to Jesus as an apostle in the bible, although the task of being an apostle is spoken of in **John 17:3** – "Now this is eternal life: that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent."

Moses is also spoken of as one who was sent. We read in **Exodus 3:10** – "So now, go. I am sending you to Pharaoh to bring my people the Israelites out of Egypt."

#### There are a number of verses in John's Gospel about Jesus being SENT:

John 5:36-37 "I have testimony weightier than that of John. For the very work that the Father has given me to finish, and which I am doing, testifies that the Father has sent me. v37 And the Father who sent me has himself testified concerning me. You have never heard his voice nor seen his form,

John 6:44 "No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him, and I will raise him up at the last day.

John 8:42 Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love me, for I came from God and now am here. I have not come on my own; but he sent me.

John 12:49 For I did not speak of my own accord, but the Father who sent me commanded me what to say and how to say it.

John 17:25 "Righteous Father, though the world does not know you, I know you, and they know that you have sent me.

John 20:21 Again Jesus said, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you."

While Moses was initially the contact person between God and the Nation of Israel, there came a point where Aaron, became the High Priest, in order to represent Israel before God. The bible describes an incredible relationship between Moses and God.

Moses and the Glory of the LORD Exodus 33:21-23 Then the LORD said, "There is a place near me where you may stand on a rock. v22 When my glory passes by, I will put you in a cleft in the rock and cover you with my hand until I have passed by. v23 Then I will remove my hand and you will see my back; but my face must not be seen."

Jesus and the Glory of the LORD John 1:14 The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

John 6:46 No one has seen the Father except the one who is from God; only he has seen the Father.

John 8:38 I am telling you what I have seen in the Father's presence, and you do what you have heard from your father."

In John 17 we have the true "LORD'S PRAYER." He prays for Himself, then the Disciples, then he prays for all those who would believe in HIM, without ever seeing him. AND THAT IS US.

#### MOSES was a great servant of God, yet he failed in many ways:

- 1. He did not trust in God's ability to overcome his speech problem.
- 2. He did not follow all of God's instructions.

  Numbers 20:8-11"Take the staff, and you and your brother

  Aaron gather the assembly together. **Speak to that rock** before
  their eyes and it will pour out its water. ... v11 Then Moses raised
  his arm and **struck the rock** twice with his staff. Water gushed
  out, and the community and their livestock drank.

#### JESUS never failed in obedience:

John 6:38 For I have come down from heaven not to do my will but to do the will of him who sent me.

Matthew 26:39 Going a little farther, he fell with his face to the ground and prayed, "My Father, if it is possible, may this cup be taken from me. Yet not as I will, but as you will."

John 4:34 "My food," said Jesus, "is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work.

Yet, Jesus, who only spent about 30 years on earth, 3 of which were in office, TURNED THE WORLD UPSIDEDOWN. He took 12 ordinary men, with a group of about 120 other committed followers and established a way of life that has revolutionised our world. About one-third of the world claim to follow Him in one way or another. His teachings have influenced every facet of life, even those fields that reject HIM today.
