- 20. WATCH THE RATIONAL MIND. It is possible to use natural wisdom to rationalize. Proverbs 3:5 says, "Lean not to thing own understanding, in all your ways acknowledge Him."
- 21. WITHSTAND FEAR. "Perfect love drives out fear." 1
 John 4:18. With God as a loving heavenly Father, His
 will is "the best thing that could happen to us." What to
 fear is being outside the security of His perfect bill.
 Romans 12:2.
- 22. WEAKNESS DOES NOT DISQUALIFY Christians often resist God's will because they don't feel adequate for that to which God is calling them. But His commission carries the guarantee of His enabling. Philippians 4:13, I Corinthians 1:27-29. 12:7-30; 2 Corinthians 12:10
- **23. WAITING IN COMPLETE PASSIVITY** is not Scriptural. Guidance won't just "arrive". Use the means given in a positive way. Psalm 32:9
- **24. WALK BY FAITH**. Be prepared to step out in faith. If you know God has spoken, then the only course is to launch out into the deep, trusting Him implicitly. Luke 5:1-9

KNOWING GOD'S WILL

- 1. WITHDRAW from all known sin. (Psalm 66:18)
 Confess it and seek God's will as a cleansed person.(1
 John 1:9.)
- 2. WILLINGNESS to submit to the Lord's direction is a basic pre-requisite. Be committed. (Romans 12:1, 2)
- 3. WANTING TO KNOW! What is your heart's desire? Is the will of God your SUPREME concern? See John 4:34, Matthew 6:33
- **4. WAITING ON GOD**. This means "keep the matter constantly before God in prayer" (Isaiah 40:31.)
- 5. WHOLEHEARTED TRUST. Proverbs 3:5, 6 says, "Trust in the Lord with ALL your heart." James says, "A double-minded man is unstable ..." IMPLICITLY TRUST God about this matter.
- 6. **WEAR CHRIST'S YOKE** See Matthew 11:29 Taking His YOKE means: (a) learning from close contact. (b) being steered in the right direction, (c) moving at the right pace
- 7. WORD OF GOD. The Holy Spirit will never lead you contrary to the truths of God's Word.(Psalm 119:11.) (Beware of isolating special verses and taking them as guidance, unless confirmed to you in other ways.)

- 8. WEIGHING THE CIRCUMSTANCES. Make a spiritually minded interpretation of events. Remember Satan acts to deter and hinder us from God's will. (1 Thessalonians 2:18; 1 Timothy 4:1)
- 9. WISDOM OF COUNSELLORS. Share your concern with spiritually-minded seniors whose opinion you value. Very often confirmation comes through their reaction or advice. (Proverbs I:5, 12:15. 16:7)
- **10. WAYS OF GUIDANCE FOR OTHERS**. Study the manner in which God has guided His servants both from Scripture, Church History and Missionary Biography, e.g. Acts 10
- 11. WETTING THE FLEECE When it is hard to distinguish between personal feelings and the Spirit's confirmation, ask God to do something objective outside yourself, as an indication of His will. See Judges 6:37-39 (Gideon's fleece)
- **12. WRITE OUT A BALANCE SHEET.** It is good to sit down with a sheet of paper and actually list the points for and against taking a particular decision.
- 13. WORK WITH A PRAYER PARTNER (OR GROUP) If the issue is of long-term significance, it is an excellent idea to open up freely to someone who will stand with you in positive faith for God's mind to be revealed. (Matthew 18:20)

- 14. WORK TO ESTABLISH SPIRITUAL PRINCIPLES.

 Often specific guidance is not needed because the issue should be governed by a known spiritual principle. e.g. "obey those that have the rule over you." (Hebrews 13:17.) 'No soldier gets tangled up in worldly affairs' (2 Timothy 2:4.)
- **15. WATCH FOR THE SPIRIT'S EQUIPMENT**. The Holy Spirit's gifts can also be an indication of the type of service God wants you to do. See Romans 12:6-10
- 16. WITNESS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT. The Holy Spirit invariably CONFIRMS by an inner assurance what God is showing you in other ways. Acts 11:12; Colossians 3:15 "Lct the peace of God be the umpire in your hearts." At the same time beware of a peace which is simply the absence of tension following a time of decision making
- **17. WATCH THE "FLESH"!** Beware of decisions that line up with affluence and natural desires. Galatians 5:24
- **18. BE AWARE OF COUNTERFEIGHTS!** Satan has seducing (misleading) spirits. Often the good is the enemy of the best. Watch for deflection on to a less vital target. Acts 6:1-6; 1 Timothy 4:1
- 19. WORLD CAN ALLURE! The world in not so much a place as a system. Ensure that your decision is in no way influenced by love of position, security, promotion, career or family pressure. 1 John 2:15-17; Luke 14:26
